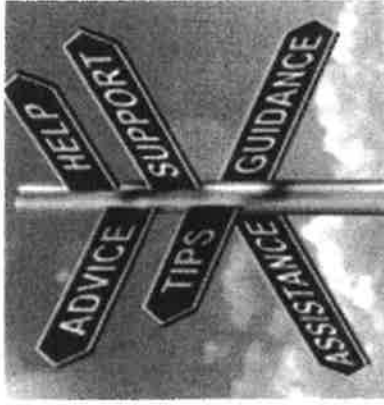
About The Wellness Center

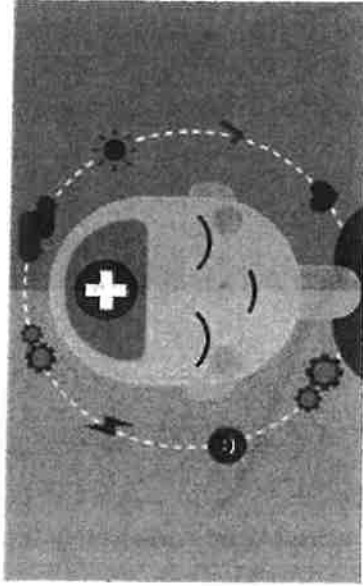

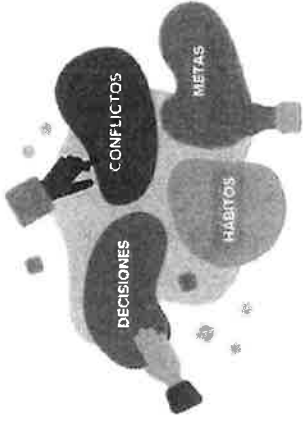

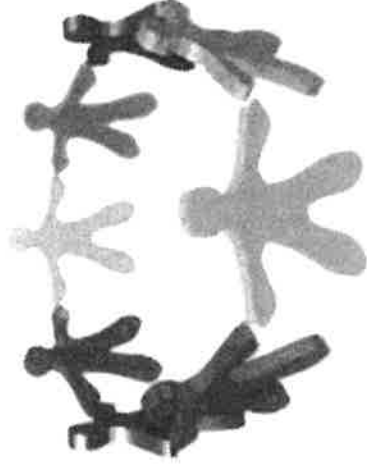
