





Eligibility: 2.0 GPA, college enrollment (applied plan to attend), Enrolled Tribal Member

Documents Needed: Digital Transcript/ Copy of Tribal affiliation parents or grandparents enrollment / birth certificate / PHOTO

Award Amounts: 6,000 scholarships, \$7.723 million
