Describe your project for the 2022-2023 School Year (SY) Implementation. (Brief, yet specific that includes the actions, implementation, purchases, etc.):

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the district has received significant funding to support the district's response and mitigation of the negative effects experienced by students and staff stemming from learning loss, regression of learning, increased anxiety, decreased connections. Remote learning and work environments required adjustments in the use of technologies and systems to reduce barriers.

The district developed an ESSER III plan that categories projects to implement that address the particular needs of students and staff. There are more than 40 individual projects that require oversight and support from district administrative staff. In order to effectively provide oversight and confirm timely and transparent implementation of projects, it is requested for the continuation of a project management platform. Assigned project staff will work with the district's procurement department for the project management platform. The project management platform will provide other project contacts the ability to inform the district's administration of progress and effectiveness in alignment with the intent and purpose of the ESSER III funds.

Another aspect of this project is to procure services of a Microsoft Power Apps Developer to create a sustainable technology system to meets the purpose of accountability which will aid in the response to educational partners (stakeholders) and funding entities confirming compliance of regulatory requirements. By have a robust system, district administration will be able to demonstrate effectiveness of the funds throughout the term of the grant and required periods of accountability.

Additional compensation may be expended on various support staff in the development and memorization of systems/practices/policies that lead to improved response to services and needs of students in the event of a pandemic or virus that negatively affects the instructional services and supports or our students.
