- 1. Any combination of education, training and experience equivalent to completion of 12th grade.
- No Child Left Behind Requirements
 (48 college semester units or more from an accredited college or university <u>OR</u>
 Paraprofessional Proficiency Exam Certificate showing compliance of NCLB)
- 3. Stockton Unified School District Bilingual Proficiency Certificate in the language of need.

Paraprofessional Proficiency Exam (NCLB) details:

The Paraprofessional Proficiency (NCLB) Exam is offered on select Mondays at 8am in the SUSD District office at 56 S. Lincoln St. Stockton, Ca 95203 (must register in advance).

Bring a picture ID and proof of high school completion (diploma or transcript), allow up to 4 hours to complete the exam.
