What is Families in Transition?

The SUSD Families in Transition program supports families with current SUSD enrolled children who are experiencing barriers in educational support.

This program is designed to identify children in need to assure they receive an adequate education, are able to participate in school events, extracurricular activities, and attend school regularly as per McKinney-Vento Federal Law.

SERVICES PROVIDED

School enrollment assistance
Assisting in the determination of school of origin or school in the best interest of the child
Academic advocacy Transportation support Extracurricular/Sports participation support Resource & referral

PROGRAM ELIGIBILTY

Children and Families sleeping in...

Hotel/Motel

Car/Trailer
Unsheltered: park, etc.
Substandard (no water, electricity, etc.)
Homeless/Transitional Shelter
Doubled-Up/"Couch Surfing"
Migrant hildren who meet any of the living circumstances described above.

Unaccompanied Minors

Currently enrolled in SUSD (or pending enrollment)

Currently in transition or an unaccompanied youth by the following definitions as per federal McKinney-Vento Law.

Child living with a caregiver who is not their parent or legal guardian by court
Youth who does not have stable housing, support, and/or is not currently with a legal parent or guardian.
