COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

DANCE 36A Hip Hop Dance 1

This course introduces students to basic skills and techniques of Hip Hop dance variations. Students will learn and explore dance combinations using a variety of music. This course offers a study of the cultural and social expression of Hip Hop. It also surveys the historical roots, the afro-diasporic dance traits that Hip Hop shares with traditional African dance. (UC, CSU)

ENG 1A Reading and Composition

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level & GPA≥2.6. Must submit ENG clearance form to enroll | This is a transfer-level, college freshman English composition course comparable to those courses offered by the state college and university systems. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID ENGL 100)

HIST 2A World History to 1600

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level | This course surveys world societies from prehistoric times to 1600. Emphasis is on the interaction and comparison of peoples and cultures, and tracing concurrent political, social, cultural, economic, and religious developments. The course examines the key elements of various cultures and their legacy for the global community today. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID HIST 150)
