HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Stockton School for Adults offers individualized programs to enable adult students to complete their high school diploma. Classes are open to all persons 18 years of age and older.

Diploma candidates are required to pass the following courses of study:

A minimum of five (5) credits must be completed at the Stockton School for Adults and students must complete Algebra 1 (Ed Code 51224.5). Some of these credits may be earned through military experience or previous work experience. Physical education credits do not apply toward Stockton School for Adults' graduation requirements. An adult education counselor will assist students in determining the specific requirements of each individual program. Graduation requirements at Stockton School for Adults may change pending approval by the Board of Education. Courses in GED preparation and Elementary Basic Skills do not earn high school credits for the diploma.
