CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE & ANTI-BIAS WORK (JULY 2023 - PRESENT)

Culturally Resposive Teaching & the Brain

Over 150 SUSD educators engaged in a book study of Culturally Responsive Teaching and the Brain.

Participants explored strategies to build trust, deepen learning, and reflect on personal bias and beliefs—strengthening culturally responsive practices that support all students.

SUSD is addressing disparities in policies and practices to promote fairness and inclusivity. Through training and data-informed decision making, diverse teams from all 55 schools are examining systems that impact student outcomes.

We are fostering shared understanding and accountability to create equitable learning environments for all through the co-creation of a three year action plan.



Multi-Tiered Systems of Support and Restorative Practices

SUSD is implementing the Synergy MTSS module to strengthen district-wide supports for the whole child.

This cross-departmental effort aligns restorative practices with tiered interventions, ensuring all students receive the academic and social-emotional support they need.

Anti-Racist Work

SUSD trained all counselors and site administration staff to adopt an anti-racist approach to teaching and learning that will further address institutional and systemic barriers that undermine student success.

These practices develop a culture that recognizes unconscious bias and creates positive communication and connections with students and adults from different ethnic groups and backgrounds.



Culturally Responsive Teaching

Ten schools partnered with Dr. Sharroky Hollie to improve student engagement through culturally responsive strategies.

Staff received coaching on lesson design and validation of students' cultural identities and assets, enhancing classroom practices across sites.

The initiative will be expanded to additional schools next year.
