RE: STATE AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS DOCUMENTATION AND RETENTION

Stockton Unified School District has a contractual responsibility to ensure all facets of the Title I, II, III, IV and other state and federal program obligations are met. The district enters into this agreement when accepting state and federal funding to support the students of Stockton.

The district's Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 3230 describes the district's responsibility to comply with all requirements detailed in any grant agreement with an awarding agency and with the federal Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards specified in Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations, at Sections 200.0200.521 and Appendices I-XII, and any stricter state laws or District policy.
