A total of 31 representatives and/or alternates were present at this meeting and 23 schools represented. District staff present Dr. Israel Gonzalez (Director of LDO, and Norma Mercado Serafin and Leticia Rodriguez (LDO Interpreters), Paola Juarez (Parent Liaison LDO), and Olivia Fernández (Administrative Assistant at LDO)

- **3.0 Oral suggestions and comments from the community regarding agenda items:** Paola Juarez (Parent Liaison), explained how these comments are given which are only 3 comments. There were no comments.
- **4.0 Changes to the Agenda:** Camelia Bernal and Dr. Israel Gonzalez added the following items to today's agenda:
- -Item 7.2 Subcommittee for the Needs Survey will be added, and item 8.1 will be moved to 10.2 Election Results. Motions were asked to make the changes, first motion was made by Sandra Arreola, second motion was made by Francisca Vargas, all in favor, and the changes were made.

- -Pittman School and Nightingale School are not on the attendance list and need to be added.

Paola Juarez explained to the parents that the names of the school representatives had not been updated on the day the minutes were sent, therefore, the information that is in the system is used until it is updated.
