- **ELD**: Instruction for English language development
- **Integrated ELD**: Instruction in which the state-adopted ELD standards are used in tandem with the stateadopted academic content standards. Integrated ELD includes specifically designed academic instruction in English (SDAIE).
- **Designated ELD**: Instruction provided during a time during the regular school day for focused instruction on the state-adopted ELD standards to assist English learners to develop critical English language skills necessary for academic content learning in English. (ELD within course and content area.)
- **Departmentalized ELD**: English Language Development- offered in a standalone departmentalized classroom
- **Bilingual Instruction**: Instruction for primary language development and content instruction delivered in the primary language

CCSD Codes:

S17D: This certificate, when held in conjunction with a basic teaching credential specified in Education Code Section 44203(e), authorizes the holder to provide the following services to limited-English-proficient pupils: (1) **specially designed content instruction delivered in English** in the subject and the grade authorized by the teacher's basic credential, and (2) instruction for **English language development to students in a departmentalized class** in the subject and the grade authorized by the teacher's basic credential.

S17S: This certificate, when held in conjunction with a prerequisite credential specified in Education Code Section 44203(e), authorizes the holder to provide instruction for **English language development to students in a self-contained classroom**.

S17A: This certificate, when held in conjunction with a teaching or services credential specified in Education Code Section 44253.11(a), authorizes the holder to provide services to English learners in **specially designed content instruction delivered in English** in the subject and the grade authorized by the teacher's credential
