6. New Business a. Review SPSA suggestions from ELAC b. Approve SPSA	<p>a. Brandy shared with members that last year’s federal review, our site was not checked, showed that our district would not pass and it would be possible that sites could lose funding if it continued. This year our district is saying the following: formatting for the SPSA must be changed, we must include specific target groups such as FIT students, African American students, EL students, Special Needs students. She shared with ELAC this information as well. ELAC suggested and was in agreement that we continue forward with focusing on PLCs, AVID, PBIS because it is working for our school site.</p> <p>Brandy also shared with members that 4th grade won our September monthly attendance challenge with 96% of those students did not miss any school days for the month. ELAC did recommend that our school provide more books in Spanish for our bilingual program, training for parents in AVID and PBIS. Brandy also shared that our site will be provided an additional bilingual assistant by the district to further add support to students that received an ELPAC level of 1. Also, another thing that our site has been pushing for is to receive student planners in Spanish which helps EL students in vocabulary and other areas. Also monies are being put into AVID, which the goal is for College readiness, which encompasses binders, organization, other materials, college research, college trips, training for teachers to learn how to advance students towards college. Other monies are being put into PBIS and PLCs.</p> <p>b. Daniel Molina made the motion to approve the new SPSA which includes all the suggestions from ELAC. Elizabeth Leaños seconded the motion.
